

<u>A 188</u> (NG 2723) resting at Ipswich, Foundation Street depot, having returned from Stowmarket on service 204. A 188, along with many other Leyland TS2's was rebodied at ECW in the 1950s with a 56 seat lowbridge body. This bus was new in July 1932 and lasted in service until 1961.



<u>A 197</u> (NG 2732) is a 1932 Leyland TS2 delivered new to Eastern Counties in July 1932 and, like most members of this class, was rebodied by ECW in the 1950s as a lowbridge 56 seater. Seen here in Denmark Road, Lowestoft whilst operating local service 3 to Oulton Broad. The bus was withdrawn in 1960.



<u>A 209</u> (NG 3870) is a 1933 built Leyland Titan TD2 seen here in Lowestoft's Denmark Road sporting its new ECW 1950s highbridge 56 seat body. This bus was the last of the NG registered batch of TD2s and is seen here operating local service 3 on a warm summer day in the early 1960s. Was later AH 209 & AH 20.



<u>AH 226</u> (VG 4824) is a 1932 built Leyland Titan TD2 carrying replacement ECW lowbridge 48 seat bodywork. This fine vehicle was caught by the camera resting in Colchester Bus Park, having travelled from Ipswich on service 207. These vehicles were easily recognisable by their unusually shaped radiators.
