



## WYE VALLEY

Commencing: MONDAYS, 19th June; 17th July;  
7th August; 11th September.

MONDAY—We leave Norwich at 8.30 a.m. and Cambridge at 10.45 a.m., and set off across England by way of Bedford to Buckingham. After lunch at the White Hart Hotel we proceed via Aynho, noted for the “apricot trees” lining the walls of houses. Here also may be noticed the Old Stocks on the roadside. Then through Chipping Norton and Stow-on-the-Wold with varied scenery and pleasantly wooded slopes, and a charming run of 30 minutes along the fringe of the Cotswolds brings us to the famous inland Spa, Cheltenham. A short stop here for tea, with some little time allowed to see some of the noble crescents and attractive shops. Now to Gloucester where a short stop will allow a visit to the ancient Cathedral, when, after an all too brief stay, we journey to Ross for dinner and the night at the Chase Hotel, Ross-on-Wye.
