SPORTING EVENTS

Renowned for its Castle, one of the finest Royal residences in the world. Begun by William the Conqueror, it occupies a commanding site near the banks of the Thames.



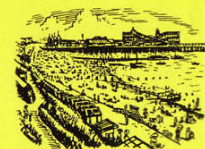
SOUTHEND-ON-SEA
