ROAD DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW

Thursford Steam Museum is situated approximately 2 miles east of the main A148 King's Lynn - Cromer road. The postcode for sat-navs is **NR21 0AS**.

From Great Yarmouth & Lowestoft...

For those travelling from Great Yarmouth & Lowestoft, the best route is via the A47 (from Yarmouth) or A146 (from Lowestoft) to the A47 Norwich Southern Bypass and follow signs for Swaffham. Continue on A47 towards Swaffham and then take a right turn approx ¼ mile past Honingham church (SP Weston Longville/Lenwade). Follow signs for Lenwade until you reach the A1067 Norwich-Fakenham road. Turn left and continue towards Fakenham. Turn right at an unsigned junction just past Langor Bridge Garage and follow this road through to the A148 at Little Snoring, then turn right towards Holt and Cromer. Continue along the A148 until you reach the village of Thursford and turn left towards Thursford Green by the Crawfish PH. Take the next turning left towards Thursford Green and continue to the museum which will be found on the right just before the village is reached.

From Norwich...

If you are coming from Norwich, take the A1067 towards Fakenham. Turn right at an unsigned junction just past Langor Bridge Garage and follow this road through to the A148 at Little Snoring, then turn right towards Holt and Cromer. Continue along the A148 until you reach the village of Thursford and turn left towards Thursford Green by the Crawfish PH. Take the next turning left towards Thursford Green and continue to the museum which will be found on the right just before the village is reached.

From Ipswich...

If you are coming from Ipswich, take the A14 & then A140 to A47 Norwich Southern Bypass and follow signs for Swaffham. Continue on A47 towards Swaffham and then take a right turn approx ¼ mile past Honingham church (SP Weston Longville/Lenwade). Follow signs for Lenwade until you reach the A1067 Norwich-Fakenham road. Turn left and continue towards Fakenham. Turn right at an unsigned junction just past Langor Bridge Garage and follow this road through to the A148 at Little Snoring, then turn right towards Holt and Cromer. Continue along the A148 until you reach the village of Thursford and turn left towards Thursford Green by the Crawfish PH. Take the next turning left towards Thursford Green and continue to the museum which will be found on the right just before the village is reached.

From Colchester and East Essex...

If you are coming from anywhere in East Essex, take the A12 north to Ipswich (Copdock Interchange) and then follow the A14 to its junction with the A140. Follow A140 to the Norwich Southern Bypass and follow signs for Swaffham. Continue on A47 towards Swaffham and then take a right turn approx ¼ mile past Honingham church (SP Weston Longville/Lenwade). Follow signs for Lenwade until you reach the A1067 Norwich-Fakenham road. Turn left and continue towards

Fakenham. Turn right at an unsigned junction just past Langor Bridge Garage and follow this road through to the A148 at Little Snoring, then turn right towards Holt and Cromer. Continue along the A148 until you reach the village of Thursford and turn left towards Thursford Green by the Crawfish PH. Take the next turning left towards Thursford Green and continue to the museum which will be found on the right just before the village is reached.

From London & the South...

For those travelling from London and the South, the best approach is via the M11 and A11 to Barton Mills Roundabout and then the A1065 to Brandon, Swaffham and Fakenham. Then take the A148 towards Cromer. Stay on the A148 until you reach Thursford village and then turn left towards Thursford Green by the Crawfish PH. Take the next turning left towards Thursford Green and continue to the museum which will be found on the right just before the village is reached.

From the North...

For those travelling from the **North**, the best approach is via the A1, then the A17 to Sleaford and thence to King's Lynn. If you are coming from **Nottingham and the East Midlands**, take the A52 via Grantham to the A17 and follow to King's Lynn. If you are coming from **Lincoln**, take the A15 to Sleaford and then the A17 to King's Lynn.

From King's Lynn, take the A148 to Fakenham and continue on the A148 towards Cromer until you reach Thursford village and then turn left towards Thursford Green by the Crawfish PH. Take the next turning left towards Thursford Green and continue to the museum which will be found on the right just before the village is reached.

From the Midlands...

If you are travelling from the Midlands, take the A14 eastwards towards Cambridge, then the A11 towards Norwich as far as Barton Mills Roundabout and then take the A1065 to Brandon, Swaffham and Fakenham. Then take the A148 towards Cromer. Stay on the A148 until you reach Thursford village and then turn left towards Thursford Green by the Crawfish PH. Take the next turning left towards Thursford Green and continue to the museum which will be found on the right just before the village is reached.

From Leicester & Peterborough...

If you are coming from Leicester take the A47 eastwards to Peterborough, Wisbech and King's Lynn. From King's Lynn, take the A148 to Fakenham and continue on the A148 towards Cromer until you reach Thursford village and then turn left towards Thursford Green by the Crawfish PH. Take the next turning left towards Thursford Green and continue to the museum which will be found on the right just before the village is reached.
