Most routes will depart from and terminate at the bus stands behind the County Hall, the exception being the 13a and 13b routes to Costessey which will depart from and terminate in the city centre (St Stephens Street).

- Regular shuttle service between the city centre and County Hall to allow for connections to be made.
- Printed time tables for all routes available on the day.
- Lunchtime drinks and refreshments available at the Oval public house, Dereham Road (now the Cherry Tree), which will be open all day to welcome patrons of this event.



- Travel to the Oval on a fully restored former Eastern Counties 1950 Bristol L5G saloon, which will be operating former Eastern Counties routes 13a and 13b from the city centre to Costessey all day. First departure 10am from St Stephens Street.
